Two Day workshop organized by Department of Computer Science

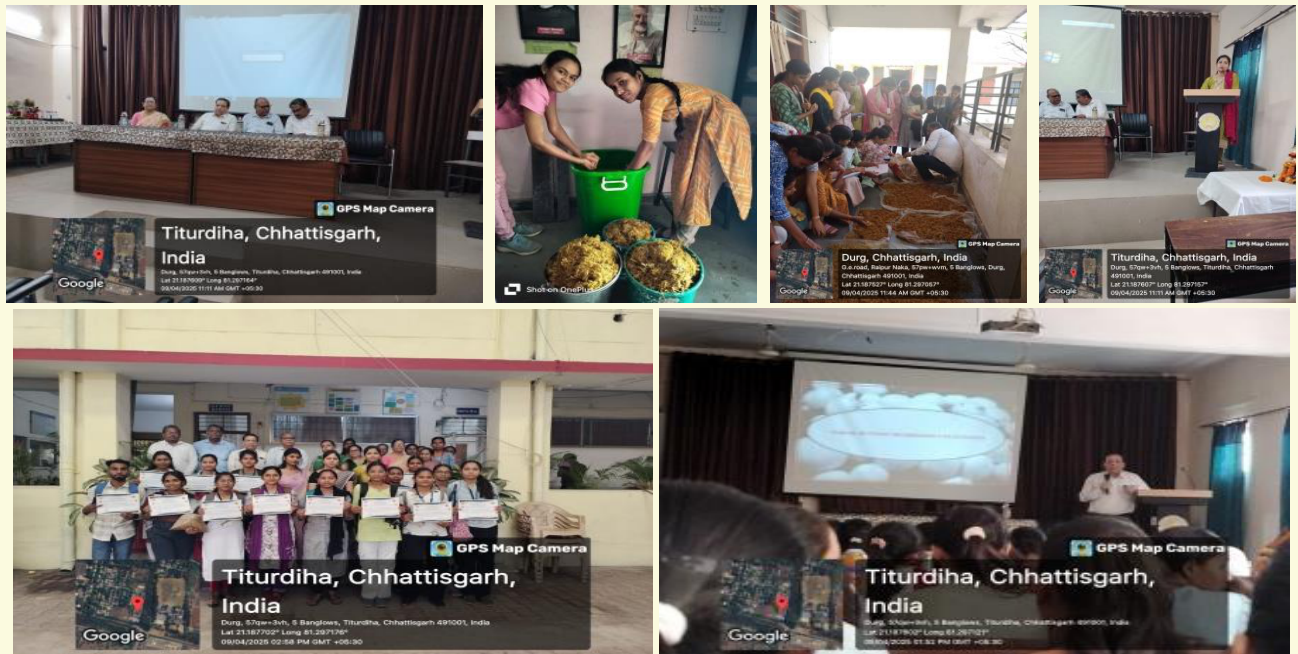
The Department of Computer Science conducted a two-day workshop on “**Cloud Computing, Generative AI and MS Office**” under the guidance of Principal Dr. Ranjana Shrivastava. At the inauguration, HOD **Mr. Ganesh Ram Nayak** introduced the concepts of Generative AI and Cloud Computing, along with their advantages and limitations. The Principal discussed the responsible and ethical use of AI. On first day Resource Person **Mr. Dileep Kumar Sahu** delivered an extensive session covering Generative AI tools, prompt-based online PPT creation, text-to-image and video generation, online quiz creation and participation, and detailed demonstrations of MS Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. The session was coordinated by **Ms. Neeku Sahu** and attended by many faculty members and students. **On second day** Resource Person **Mr. Homi Mahikwar** from Avish Educom, Durg, explained Cloud Computing, Cloud Storage Providers, and the increasing importance of cloud technologies in modern computer science. The valedictory session included the presence of the Principal, faculty members, and students, during which **certificates were awarded** to all participants.





Two Days Workshop – Hands On Training In Mushroom Cultivation

Guest Lecture on Indian Economy and Rural Development

On April 2, 2025, the Department of Economics organized a guest lecture under the guidance of Principal Dr. Ranjana Srivastava. The guest speaker, **Dr. Anshumala Chandnagar**, Assistant Professor of Economics at Govt. V.Y.T. Autonomous PG College, Durg, delivered a lecture on **“New Dimensions of Indian Economy and Rural Development.”** The program began with remarks by **Dr. D.C. Agrawal**, Head of the Department, who emphasized the government’s initiatives aimed at improving rural education, skills, and livelihoods through schemes such as **MGNREGA, PM Rural Employment Scheme, Common Service Centers, PM Awas Yojana, and e-Panchayat.** Principal Dr. Ranjana Srivastava highlighted that India’s economic development is strongly linked to rural progress, as a large share of the population resides in villages. Dr. Chandnagar discussed the transition from traditional agriculture-based rural economies to modern systems involving **mechanization, solar energy, and advanced farming techniques.** She noted improvements in GDP (up to **45.76%**) and declining rural poverty due to various government initiatives. Key components such as **infrastructure, sustainability, inclusive growth,** and modern farming practices—including **organic farming, crop rotation, integrated pest management, and water conservation**—were emphasized for strengthening the rural economy. The event was conducted by **Dr. Mukta Bakhala**, and the vote of thanks was proposed by **Dr. Deepak Kashyap.** The students of M.A. Economics and faculty members attended the session.



Extension Activity by Zoology Department

The Zoology department organized an extension activity on 28 March 2025. 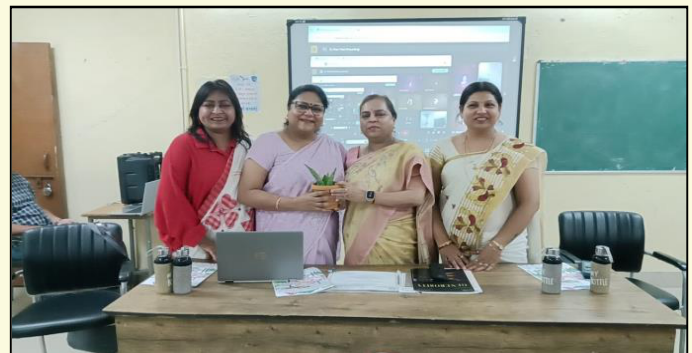
Guest lecture organized by department of computer science

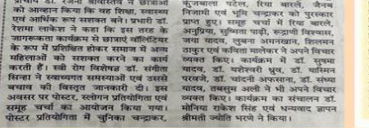

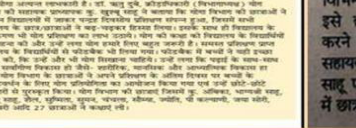

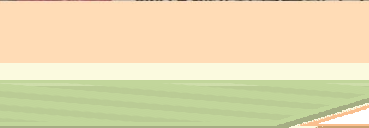
